REQUEST FORM TO TRANSFER THE RIGHT TO USE AN ".ES" DOMAIN NAME PURSUANT TO THE DECISION HANDED DOWN IN THE EXTRAJUDICIAL CONFLICT RESOLUTION PROCEDURE ESTABLISHED IN THE NATIONAL PLAN FOR INTERNET DOMAIN NAMES UNDER THE COUNTRY CODE FOR SPAIN (".ES"), APPROVED BY ORDER ITC/1542/2005, DATED 19 MAY. ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFERRING AN ".ES" DOMAIN NAME AND REQUEST TO MODIFY THE REGISTRATION DATA. AUTHORISATION FOR A REGISTRAR TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE ASSIGNEE.

HEREBY STATES

One. That _____³ is the owner of the domain name(s) _____.

Two. That, pursuant to the Sole Additional Provision, letter f), of the National Plan for Internet domain names under the country code for Spain (".es"), approved by Order ITC/1542/2005, dated 19 May, the person or entity initiating the Extrajudicial Conflict Resolution procedure shall be given priority in obtaining the domain name, if the transfer request is submitted within the period established by the procedure rules.

HEREBY STATES THAT

One. He or she authorises the Registrar _____ (hereinafter, "the Registrar") to act on his or her behalf before Red.es, and to take all actions necessary for the assignment and renewal of the domain name(s) _____ including receiving the corresponding notifications.

Two. He or she authorises the Registrar to take any actions necessary to make the payments on his or her own behalf corresponding to the domain name(s) assignment and renewal, which is hereby requested for subsequent years.

Three. He or she has been sufficiently informed by the Registrar and understands the rules and procedures in effect, terms and conditions, fees and forms of payment and technical requirements established for the registration of ".es" domain names with the mediation of a Registrar, and accepts them completely. Specifically, the Applicant understands the rules, procedures, terms and conditions for the registration of an ".es" domain name, the content of which is available at: <http://www.dominios.es>.

Four. He or she understands that failure to comply with these rules will result, in the cases in which it is thus expressly established, in the loss of the domain name and possible reassignment at that time to any applicant legitimately eligible to register it.

Five. Excepting error or omission in good faith, the data provided on this form are true.

Six. He or she agrees to keep the information provided on this form updated at all times, reporting any changes to the Registrar, who will inform Red.es, whenever there are any modifications to any of the data that must be sent to the Register. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in the domain name being cancelled, in accordance with the procedure established for said purpose (for example, due to the impossibility of contacting the individuals listed as domain name managers because changes to the contact data or change of managers have not been reported as duly established).

Seven. Red.es will act in accordance with the data received from the Transferee in the processing of the actions related to assigning and renewing the domain name, as indicated in the section above.

Eight. He or she understands and accepts that any false data provided on this form may be grounds for rejecting the domain name transfer and that, in this case, the domain name will be made available for future registration by another eligible applicant.

Nine. He or she understands and accepts that, once Red.es provides confirmation to the Registrar that the right to use the domain name has been transferred, the Registrar shall be required to make payment, on behalf of the Transferee and within the established periods of time, for the corresponding fee for the assignment or, when appropriate, renewal, and that failure to make payment or insufficient payments after the established periods of time will be grounds for making the domain name available from that moment for registration by a legitimate applicant, with Red.es assuming no responsibility whatsoever for the consequences of Registrar's failure to comply with its obligations to the Transferee.

Ten. He or she understands and accepts that the Registrar plays a mediation role in the assignment and management of ".es" domain names, and is solely and exclusively responsible for compliance with the requirements stipulated in the mediation contract for the assignment of domain names. The Applicant is deemed to have been informed of this situation and expressly waives the right to any action or claim against Red.es derived from the Registrar's failure to comply with its obligations.

Eleven. He or she understands and accepts that, in the event of failure to comply with the rules and technical conditions established by the Assignment Authority for the proper functioning of the ".es" domain names system, a domain name may be cancelled temporarily or permanently.

Twelve. To the best of his or her knowledge, the use of the Domain Name does not infringe upon the rights of third parties.

Thirteen. That he or she understands and accepts that the assignment of an ".es" domain name entails acceptance of the extrajudicial conflict resolution system for the use of domain names related to, among others, the industrial property rights protected in Spain, such as the trade names, protected trademarks, designations of origin, business names; or the official designations or those generally recognised as belonging to Spanish Public Administrations and public entities, in accordance with the procedure established in the Regulations for extrajudicial conflict resolution regarding the use of ".es" domain names, published on the web page www.dominios.es.

Fourteen. He or she understands and accepts that the results of the extrajudicial conflict resolution system are binding for the parties and for the Assignment Authority.



Fifteen. He or she understands and accepts that the assignment and registration of the domain name gives the exclusive rights to its use, in the terms set forth in the applicable legislation, for the purposes of addressing in the internet domain name system.

Sixteen. The administrative contact person designated on the application has sufficient power of attorney to do so, is responsible for any incident related to the right to use the domain name and understands and accepts these circumstances.

Seventeen. All entities and individuals related to this form understand and expressly accept that the personal data provided are included in the internal and public databases maintained by Red.es and that they will be kept under said conditions in the terms required for the management of the “.es” Domain Name Register, in accordance with Organic Law 15/1999, dated 13 December: the Personal Data Protection Act.

Eighteen. That they understand and accept that the rights of access and rectification may be exercised directly with the Registrar at their registered offices in _____⁶, in accordance with the legislation on personal data protection. The rights to cancellation and opposition may only be exercised subsequent to forfeiting the requested domain name, since Red.es is required to process the personal data to assign and renew the domain name.

Red.es, located at www.red.es, shall handle the personal data of the individuals and entities mentioned in accordance with Organic Law 15/1999, dated 13 December, the Personal Data Protection Act, and its executive legislation, and shall not use them for any purpose other than to assign and renew the domain name. You are hereby informed that assignment of the domain name requires the personal data to be published in the “.es” domain name Register database, which is accessible to the public on the internet.

Nineteen. He or she understands and accepts that the personal data provided on this form, as the beneficiary of a domain name, may likewise be subject to processing by Red.es as part of its work to develop and promote the Information Society and for historical, statistical or research purposes; they may be transferred for the same purposes to other Administrations in the cases set forth in sections one and two, article 21 of the Personal Data Protection Act.

Twenty. The undersigned is sufficiently authorised to accept the conditions for the transfer of the domain name, to accept that the Registrar act on his or her behalf before Red.es and carry out all actions required to assign and renew the domain name, including receiving the corresponding notifications, and requesting the modification of the registration data for the domain names indicated on this form.
