HEREBY STATES THAT

One. He or she understands and accepts the rules and procedures in effect, terms and conditions, fees and forms of payment and technical requirements established for the “.es” domain name register, the content of which is available at <http://www.dominios.es>.

Two. He or she understands that failure to comply with these rules will result, in the cases in which it is thus expressly established, in the loss of the domain name and possible reassignment at that time to any applicant legitimately eligible to register it.

Three. Excepting error or omission in good faith, the data provided on this form are true.

Four. He or she agrees to keep the information provided on this form updated, reporting any change that may occur. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in the domain name being cancelled, in accordance with the procedure established for said purpose (for example, due to the impossibility of contacting the individuals listed as domain name managers because changes to the contact data or change of managers have not been reported).

Five. Red.es will act in accordance with the data received from the Transferee in the processing of the actions related to assigning and renewing the domain name.

Six. He or she understands and accepts that any false data provided on this form may be grounds for rejecting the domain name transfer and that, in this case, the domain name will be made available for future registration by another legitimate applicant.

Seven. He or she understands and accepts that, once Red.es confirms that the right to use the domain name has been transferred, the Transferee shall be required to pay the fees corresponding to assignment or, when appropriate, renewal of the domain name, within the established periods of time.

Eight .He or she understands and accepts that in the event of failure to make payment or insufficient payment after the established time periods, the domain name will become available at that time for registration by a legitimate applicant.

Nine. He or she understands and accepts that, in the event of failure to comply with the rules and technical conditions established by the Assignment Authority for the proper functioning of the ".es" domain names system, a domain name may be cancelled temporarily or permanently.

Ten. To the best of his or her knowledge, the use of the Domain Name does not infringe upon the rights of third parties.

Eleven. He or she understands and accepts that the assignment of the ".es" domain name involves submitting to the extrajudicial conflict resolution system regarding the use of domain names in relation to, among others, industrial property rights protected in Spain, such as trade names, protected trademarks, designations of origin, company names; or the official or generally recognisable designations of the Spanish Public Administrations and public entities, in accordance with the procedure established in the Extrajudicial Conflict Resolution Regulations related to the use of ".es" domain names, published on the web page www.dominios.es.

Twelve. He or she understands and accepts that the results of the extrajudicial conflict resolution system are binding for the parties and for the Assignment Authority.

Thirteen. He or she understands and accepts that the assignment and registration of the domain name gives the exclusive rights to its use, in the terms set forth in the applicable legislation, for the purposes of addressing in the internet domain name system.

Fourteen. The administrative contact person designated on the application has sufficient power of attorney to do so, is responsible for any incident related to the right to use the domain name and understands and accepts these circumstances.

Fifteen. All entities and individuals related to this form understand and expressly accept that the personal data provided are included in the internal and public databases maintained by Red.es and that they will be kept under said conditions in the terms required for the management of the ".es" Domain Name Register, in accordance with Organic Law 15/1999, dated 13 December: the Personal Data Protection Act.

Sixteen. He or she understands and accepts that the rights to access and rectification may be exercised in accordance with the personal data protection legislation. The rights to cancellation and opposition may only be exercised subsequent to forfeiting the requested domain name, since Red.es is required to process the personal data to assign and renew the domain name.

Red.es, located at www.red.es, shall handle the personal data of the individuals and entities mentioned in accordance with Organic Law 15/1999, dated 13 December, the Personal Data Protection Act, and its



executive legislation, and shall not use them for any purpose other than to assign and renew the domain name. You are hereby informed that assignment of the domain name requires the personal data to be published in the ".es" domain name Register database, which is accessible to the public on the internet.

Seventeen. He or she understands and accepts that the personal data provided on this form, as regards the beneficiary of a domain name, may likewise be subject to processing by Red.es in the performance of its duties of developing and promoting the Information Society and for historical, statistical or research purposes, and they may be transferred, for these same purposes, to other Administrations in the cases outlined in sections one and two, article 21 of the Personal Data Protection Act.

Eighteen.-The undersigned is sufficiently authorised to accept the conditions for transferring the domain name(s) and requesting modification of the registration data for the domain names covered by this form.
