



**RESOLUTION FROM THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE
PUBLIC CORPORATE ENTITY RED.ES MODIFYING THE LIST
OF RESERVED TERMS FOR SECOND LEVEL
“.ES” DOMAIN NAMES.**

At the request of the Government of Spain, in view of the fact that the terms “español” and “española” are substantive adjectives of the constitutional bodies of the Spanish State, pursuant to the fourth provision of the Red.es Chairman's Directive, dated 12 September 2005, approving the lists of banned or reserved terms for second level “.es” domain names,

AGREEMENT

To include in the list of reserved terms provided in section Three of the Seventh Provision of the National Plan for Internet domain names under the “.es” country code for Spain, approved by Order ITC/1542/2006, of 19 May, the terms “español”, “española”, “españoles” and “españolas”.
