

RESOLUTION, HANDED DOWN BY THE PRESIDENT OF PUBLIC BUSINESS ENTITY RED.ES, UPDATING THE LIST OF TERMS PROHIBITED OR RESERVED FOR SECOND-LEVEL “. ES” DOMAIN NAMES WITH NAMES RELATING TO CONSTITUTIONAL BODIES OR OTHER STATE ORGANISATIONS

Ms María Teresa Ledo Turiel, appointed Secretary of State for Digitalisation and Artificial Intelligence by Royal Decree 40/2024 of 9 January and President of public business entity Red.es, M.P. by virtue of Royal Decree 210/2024 of 27 February, authorised for this act under section three of Provision Five of Order ITC/1542/2005 of 19 May, which approves the National Plan for Internet domain names under the country code for Spain (“.es”).

WHEREAS

ONE.- Pursuant to section three of Provision Five of Order ITC/1542/2005 of 19 May, which approves the National Plan for Internet domain names under the country code for Spain (“.es”), the President of public business entity Red.es may determine an updated list of second-level domain names relating to the names of constitutional bodies or other State institutions, which have not been previously assigned, which shall be reserved, and which, once included in this list, may not be freely assigned. This list shall be public and available electronically, free of charge.

TWO.- Based on its accumulated experience of carrying out the task of registering “.es” domain names since the approval of the lists of terms prohibited or reserved for second-level domain names by instruction of the President of public business entity Red.es, of 12 September 2005, the Assignment Authority recommends that the “.es” domain names included in the lists should be regularly updated, adding new terms in order to guarantee compliance and the fulfilment of their intended purpose.

THREE.- On 23 February 2024, the National Cryptologic Centre (CCN-CERT) requested that a series of “.es” domain names that are very similar to the “.es” domain names it uses be included in the list of reserved terms to prevent them from being registered by third parties unrelated to said organisation for potentially fraudulent purposes (phishing campaigns, disinformation, etc.).

FOUR.- Given the above, updating the list of reserved terms for ".es" domain names to include the series of domain names requested by CCN-CERT is deemed appropriate. The domain names included in said list may only be registered by the organisation that requested they be included in said list.

In view of the above,

AGREES

SOLE PARAGRAPH.- To update the list of reserved second-level ".es" domain names with the terms included in the Annex to this Resolution.
